

Installation Quick Start Guide for IPI-1 Important Installation Instructions

When installing the filter for the first time, please follow the instructions below:

- 1 Turn off the incoming water supply.
- 2 Locate a convenient location or section of tubing where you can install the filter.
- 3 Cut the tubing using a tube cutter. Please ensure that the edges of the tube are cut clean and free of sharp burrs. DO NOT cut the tubing at an angle as it may cause the unit to leak during use.

NOTE: There is a directional flow arrow on the filter. The incoming water should be routed to the inlet and the filtered water should be coming from the outlet or arrow head end of the flow arrow.

- 4 Insert supply tubing into the end of the filter. Insert firmly until the tubing bottoms out.
- 5 Turn on the water supply. Flush filter for 5 minutes or until the water runs clear.
- 6 Make sure to not damage the filter during the installation of the fittings.
- 7 Install supply side tubing
- 8 Turn on the water supply and flush filter for 5 minutes or until the water runs clear.
- 9 Turn off water supply.
- 10 Repeat Step 5 for the outlet side of the filter. Make sure to install the tubing firmly until the tubing bottoms out.
- **11** Turn on the water supply and inspect the filter for leaks.

- 2 Remove tubing from the ends of the filter.
- 3 Trim off a small section of tubing from both ends
 - Install the new filter. Refer to the "Installation" section of this document.

For old water applications only to not use with water that is microbiologically unsafe or of unknown quality without adequate disinfection before or after the system. Protect from freezing. REPLACE FULTER EVERYE MONTHS, OR IF BAD TASTE OR ODOR OCCUR.

> The risk associated with small parts can cause choking if swallowed. Keep children away from small parts during the replacement of the water filter
